Answer: 2♣

Perfect Landy hand. 5-5 in the majors. Majority of the points evenly spread between the two majors. 14 HCP ad just 5 losers

Answer: 2♣

As above. Not quite so stong but well worth a Landy bid.

Answer: Double

To strong for Landy. With 16+ HCP, any shape, you should always double a weak 1NT opeing bid.

Answer: 2♥

When 6-4 in the majors it is usually better to bid your 6 card major. If you bid Landy and partner has three cards in your 4 card suit and two cards in your 6 card suit you will miss the 6-2 major fit.

Answer: Pass

Do not bid Landy when 4-4 in the majors.

Answer: 2♥

You have an 8 card fit in hearts!

Answer: 3♥

Partner will have at most 7 losers for her Landy bid. You have 8 losers so are worth a jump to 3♥. If partner has 6 losers hand she should bid game.

Answer: 2♦

This bid asks partner to bid her longer major. You have a 7 loser hand so plan to bid game once you have located partner's 5 card major.

Answer: 4♥

Game is by no means certain but with 7 losers opposite partner's assumed 7 losers it is a reasonable gamble.

Answer: 3NT

No fit for partner but your 16 HCP justify a game bid.
